

Behavior Agreement

8th Grade Retreat to Seaside, Oregon

I, _____, agree to the rules and expectations of the class trip to Oregon. I understand I am representing University Prep and am prepared to be an ambassador for our school.

The rules while few in number, are designed to foster respect for the Hotel where we will stay as well as the beautiful environment of Seaside and maintain a relaxing and safe experience for all participants. In addition, since this is a school-sponsored retreat, all Behavior Guidelines, as outlined in our *Student/Parent Handbook* will be strictly enforced. While we certainly don't anticipate any problems, please know that violations of any retreat or school rules may result in disciplinary action (including the student being picked up and brought home by their parents from Seaside). Our chaperones will be responsible for deciding such matters.

Rules:

1. **Participate** in all activities and assignments – be where you are supposed to be, doing what you should be doing.
2. **Be in the appropriate/designated locations** at all times.
3. **Be on time** to all events and activities.
4. **All school behavior and dress code rules** and guidelines apply during our trip.
5. **No personal listening devices** (i.e. iPods) allowed during activities/lessons/hikes. You may listen to music during your free time and on the buses.
6. **No student is allowed in anyone else's hotel room.** This means you may *only* go into your own hotel room. No exceptions!
7. Students must be **in their rooms by 10 p.m.**
8. **Lights out/TV off by 10:30 p.m. SHARP!** You may not call other rooms after 10:30 p.m. Your room should be quiet after 10:30 p.m.
9. **Obey all hotel rules.**
10. **No running/being loud in the hall.** When you are in the hall, others should not be able to hear you from inside the rooms. Please be aware there are other customers at the hotel!
11. **Rooms must be clean each morning** before room check. Clothes must be in the dresser, in or on your bag. Wrappers must be picked up and beds must be made.
12. **You may not swim in the pool without a chaperone present.**
13. Whenever you go anywhere outside your hotel room, you must go with a UPrep buddy. Do not go anywhere alone. Bring a buddy or a couple of truddies and **stay with them at all times!**
14. There will be free-time for students, but if you are leaving the hotel during free-time, you **must inform an adult chaperone.**
