Sixth Grade:

(NOTE: a binder with dividers, pencil pouch and assignment notebook will be provided to each student by U Prep)

- Pens - blue or black
- Six #2 pencils
- Eraser
- One ream of lined, loose-leaf 8.5" x 11", 3-hole punched paper
- One 12" ruler (standard and metric scales, with 3 holes for storage in binder)
- Small set of colored pencils (12 colors)
- Scientific calculator (TI-30 or equivalent)
- 100 index cards (can be 3"x5" or 4"x6")
- Protractor
- 1 package of graph paper (4 or 5 squares per inch)
- Composition notebook
- 2" binder
- Public library card
- Work/gardening gloves

Seventh Grade:

- Three highlighter pens (blue, pink, yellow)
- Eraser
- Pen – blue or black
- Six #2 pencils
- Public library card
- Notebook for math with graphing paper (4 or 5 squares per inch works well)
- TI-30 series or TI-30XIIS is preferred, but any scientific calculator will suffice
- Protractor with 6" ruler
- Compass
- One Subject Notebook for Math

Eighth Grade:

- One 3" ring binder (common binder for all subjects)
- One ream of lined, loose leaf 8.5" x 11", 3-hole punched paper
- One 12" ruler (standard and metric scales, with 3 holes for storage in binder)
- Seven dividers for common binder
- Small set of colored pencils (12 colors)
- Three highlighter pens (blue, pink, yellow)
- Eraser
- Pen – blue or black
- Six #2 pencils
- Public library card
- A hole-punched notebook of lined paper for history notes
- A scientific calculator. The Texas Instruments "TI-34" is preferred, but any scientific calculator will do
- Graph paper
- Ruler
- Protractor and compass for those in Pre-Algebra
- Colored markers
- Composition book for Spanish
