Dear Senior:

The deadline for handing in all pictures for your senior page is Friday, November 21. This is an absolute deadline; if you don't hand in your pictures by that date, we'll use your space in the yearbook for something else.

Here are the ground rules:

1. You are welcome to design your own half-page layout; dimensions of the final layout are 7-1/2 inches wide by 4-7/8 inches tall.
2. There are no limits on the number of pictures you can use, but a good guideline is 8 to 12 images. Last year, we had some pages with up to 20, and that's fine; just be aware that the pictures will have to be pretty small to fit on the page.
3. The yearbook staff will only accept digital images. No prints. You can scan in your prints here on campus and send them to us at:

yearbook@universityprep.org

All image files must be 225 dpi. For help scanning, you will be able to turn to the following seniors who have volunteered to coordinate the senior pages: Milo Barret-Wilson, Keshav Iyengar, Alyssa Vaughan, and Thai-Hien Nguyen.

In the coming weeks, we will be sending out more details about designing the pages and placement (start thinking about who you want to share the page with). We will also ask you to sign a form committing to meeting your deadline.

For now, the most important thing to keep in mind is the deadline for pictures: Friday, November 21. Now is the time to get your portrait taken and choose the best shots from your old pictures.
