

MATRICULATION BY APPLICATION TYPE 2020




- Regular Decision 48%

MATRICULATION BY APPLICATION TYPE 2019




- Regular Decision 55%

- Early Action (nonbinding) 18%


ENROLLMENT BY GEOGRAPHIC REGION 2020




ENROLLMENT BY GEOGRAPHIC REGION 2016-2020




ENROLLMENT BY GEOGRAPHIC REGION 2020




