

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Our four-week program is dedicated to teaching the fundamental skills of skiing or snowboarding while instilling a passion for the mountain environment for all levels of participants. Skiing and riding with the same coach* each week helps participants to gain a level of comfort, familiarity, and consistency; factors that are all key to an enjoyable and successful learning experience. The first day will be dedicated to evaluation and forming groups based on ability level. Students may ski or ride with a friend of the same discipline, and will be placed into the lower group if their abilities differ.

**While we strive to keep groups with the same coach each week, if a child is progressing at a drastically different rate than the rest of their group they may be moved into another. There may be some instances of coaches missing work for illness or injury in which case a substitute coach would take over for that day or the class may combine with another.*

Ages: Skiing and snowboarding for participants ages 11-18.

Ability Levels: All levels. Please refer to our ability level chart on the Stevens Pass website.

Classes must have a minimum of 4 students in order to run.

Students in classes/levels that do not meet the minimum at the signup deadline will be merged into a lower level group or cancelled.

Times and Lessons:

All lessons are on snow from 6:30pm-8:00pm, groups meet at 6:15pm. If students are renting equipment on-mountain they must reserve ahead of time and pick up their rental gear before their lesson. We recommend giving that process about 45 minutes.

Please remember lessons do not include rental equipment, lift tickets, or snacks. All classes are subject to availability and minimum participant requirement.

Meeting Place & Pick-up:

Lessons will meet by the group of trees outside of the Tye Creek Lodge (rental shop/deli). Coaches will be available fifteen minutes before and after the on-snow portion of the lesson. Look for our "Multi-week lessons meet here" sign.

Late Arrivals/Absences:

To ensure each student is getting the most out of each lesson and to maximize teaching time, groups will leave the meeting area promptly at the lesson start time (6:30pm). If a class is missing students, the rest of the group will take a warm-up lap before returning to the corral to pick up any latecomers. Students who arrive after this point may not be able to re-join their group.

Classes missed due to absence or tardiness cannot be made-up or refunded. If the highway and/or resort closes we will discuss reschedule options with the group coordinator.

Please Note:

All lessons must be reserved by December 8th, 2017 prior to the school holiday break.

If the group coordinator wishes to receive weekly attendance records and/or progress reports at the end of the program, please inform Stevens Pass Ski & Snowboard School no later than the final registration date of the program (12/8/17).

D-Team: 7-18 year old advanced skiers and snowboarders

Advanced skiers and riders may participate in a special six-week Development Team (D-Team) running Friday nights (1/12, 19, 26, 2/2, 9, & 16). This program costs **\$199/student***. This aggressive program provides specialized training in freestyle and freeride, providing support and coaching towards and during optional event participation in select freestyle/freeride competitions in our area. The program coincides with the Western Washington USASA competition circuit which will offer local freestyle events for D-Team aged kids to participate in. The focus is to build on team chemistry and how athletes motivate and challenge each other through gaining a deeper understanding of the mechanics of the sport and realizing their own potential.

**Subject to availability and successful ability level evaluation. Participation will take place on all terrain including medium/large terrain parks. Extra travel may be required to participate in competitive events, which may not take place on program dates. Event fees do not apply.*
